

## **ENVIRONMENT AND CORPORATE RESPONSIBILITY POLICY**

### **Purpose**

This policy is designed to ensure that actions of Winton Land Limited and its subsidiaries (together the **Group**) support our ability to create long-term value for ourselves and for others.

### **Environment**

Winton must develop and build to adapt to the physical risks of climate change. Accordingly, at a minimum:

- 1. the Group's operations are to comply with relevant statutory and regulatory requirements;
- the Group will regularly monitor its environmental performance, objectives and targets and ensure that support functions exist to effectively maintain and continually improve environmental standards;
- 3. the Group must ensure that environmental care is important to every facet of the Group's management and operations; and
- 4. the Group will continue to promote individual commitment to safe and environmentally responsible behaviour through the training and education of, and dissemination of information to, all relevant team members.

### **Community & Suppliers**

The Company prides itself on the strong relationships it has established with key stakeholders, including local councils, Iwi and Kāinga Ora, over time.

The Group's suppliers include a range of organisations across different regions. While the Company has a relatively small team, it works with many contractors on each site to develop the land and construct homes and commercial spaces. We conduct a non-price attributes assessment to reflect historical performance in areas like health and safety and environmental conduct during the tender process to select contractors.
